### DOVE MAGAZINE:

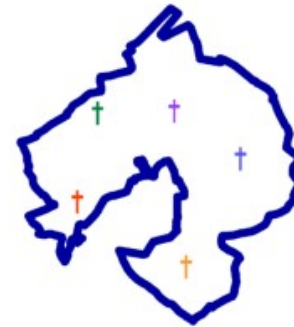
The summer edition of The Dove is available in church and the village stores of Austrey, Shuttington and Warton. Thanks to all who have contributed or helped in the distribution.
