We are in the process of getting quotes for work to make **Warton** watertight so we can progess the internal decorations, and **Shuttington** not to be left out needs work on the timber frame of the tower.

Some of this is exciting and new, some daunting and new, but we trust in the Lord that makes all things new, who in our weakness is strong. The grave could not hold Him, He brings light into darkness, for He is Risen indeed. Alleluia.
